Dogs Enter Shelters Annually

According to American Veterinarian Medical Association's 2017-2018 pet ownership study, 76M dogs live in the United States. Douglas Quenqua from the New York Times reported that 83% of all dogs in America are either spayed or neutered. Kim Kavin reported in the Washington Post demand for dogs in 2016 reached 8M. ASPCA pet statistics website states 3.3M dogs enter shelters annually and 620,000 are reunited with their owners.
